Shuttle bus - FREE trips to the train station

The BID has recently started a fully funded shuttle bus for employees in the BID area to use. It operates on a circuit to and from Bracknell Train Station in the morning and evening. Journey times coordinate with the London Waterloo Train arrivals in the morning and departures in the evening.

The shuttle bus is only available to those who work within the BID area (Western and Southern Business Areas). When boarding the shuttle bus, passengers must present their Bracknell BID 'I Work' Loyalty Card to the driver to use the service. Everyone who works within the BID area is entitled to a free 'I Work' Loyalty Card.

Shared Cycle Scheme – FREE bicycles

The BID has just started a fully funded Shared Cycle Scheme, available exclusively to everyone who works in the Western and Southern Business Areas (BID area) with electric and standard bicycles.

The bikes can be unlocked with the Donkey Republic App, free to anyone who works in the area and returned at various locations throughout the Western and Southern Business Areas, Town Centre and Bracknell



Train Station. Try them out to commute to the train station or take a leisurely lunchtime ride.

New CCTV and ANPR scheme

CCTV and ANPR cameras are about to be installed across the area over the next three months.

They aim to increase safety and security for businesses and their staff.

New signs to help find your way

The BID is currently installing a comprehensive wayfinding scheme throughout the BID area. This includes over 40 signs including welcome signs, directory totems, fingerpost signs, and subway wall signs.

The scheme has divided the BID area into zones which are colour coded to aid navigation and highlights all major destinations, including the town centre, bus and train station, green spaces and amenities, shared office spaces, and trading estates within the BID.

The scheme is set to transform how people can find their way around the area.

The BID Renewal consultation is progressing well, involving businesses across the BID area through workshops, seminars, one-to-one interviews, and surveys.

These engagements aim to ensure the new plan includes the right projects and objectives to support Bracknell BID businesses over the next five years.

Meetings and workshops provide businesses with the opportunity to shape the new business plan according to their needs.

The goal is to create a plan that is fit for purpose for the next five years, building on past achievements.

July and August: The BID
Proposal and Business Plan will
be developed, alongside 'Baseline
Agreements' with Bracknell
Forest Council and the Police
to ensure that the BID services
are supplementary to existing
services.

October: Ballot papers will be issued to businesses for voting on the plan.
